

1.1 Goals of OMG

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The [Object Management Group \(OMG\)](#) is a software consortium with an international membership of vendors, developers, and end users. Established in 1989, its mission is to help computer users solve enterprise integration problems by providing [open, vendor-neutral specifications](#) for portability, interoperability, and reusability based on the [Model-Driven Architecture \(MDA\)](#). MDA defines an approach to IT system specification that separates the specification of system functionality from the specification of its implementation on a specific technology platform, and provides guidelines for structuring specifications expressed as models. OMG has published many widely used specifications, such as [UML](#), [BPMN](#), [MOF](#), [XMI](#), [DDS](#), and [CORBA](#), to name a few.

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
