Statement

The [DIDO-TE](#) SHALL instantiate each [Test Object](#) included in a [Test Environment](#) before [Test Execution](#).

Rationale

Instantiating each included [Test Object](#) establishes the actual object subjected to evaluation during [Test Execution](#).

The instantiated Test Object provides the operating instance against which the applicable [Test Definition](#), inputs, procedures, and expected outcomes apply.

Establishing correspondence between the defined Test Object and its instantiated state supports [Traceability](#), repeatable Test Execution, and interpretation of the resulting [Test Results](#).

Verification

Verification confirms that:

- The DIDO-TE instantiates every Test Object included in the Test Environment.
- Each instantiated Test Object corresponds to a Test Object identified by the controlled Test Environment information.
- Each instantiated Test Object has the specified version, Baseline, and Configuration.
- Each instantiated Test Object enters its required initial state before Test Execution.
- The DIDO-TE maintains Traceability between each defined Test Object and its instantiated state.
- A missing, incorrect, or untraceable Test Object instance constitutes nonconformance with this requirement.

Verification includes:

- Inspection of the Test Objects identified for the Test Environment
- Inspection of each instantiated Test Object
- Comparison of each instantiated Test Object with its controlled definition
- Inspection of the version, Baseline, Configuration, and initial state of each instantiated Test Object
- Inspection of Traceability records connecting each defined Test Object to its instantiated state
- A negative assessment using a missing, incorrect, or untraceable Test Object instance
- Confirmation that the negative assessment produces a nonconformance result
