

Conformance Requirement

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Discussion

A Conformance Requirement is a [Requirement](#) whose satisfaction contributes to determining [Conformance](#).

A Conformance Requirement forms part of an applicable [Conformance Model](#) and may be included within one or more [Conformance Profiles](#).

A Conformance Requirement is evaluated using one or more [Conformance Criteria](#) at identified Conformance Points.

Definition

requirement whose satisfaction contributes to determining conformance

Note

Not every Requirement in a specification necessarily constitutes a Conformance Requirement.

A specification identifies which Requirements participate in Conformance Assessment.

Example

A DIDO-TE Requirement stating that a test implementation shall preserve required Evidence is a Conformance Requirement because its satisfaction contributes to determining Conformance.

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
