

Oversight Consumption Role

Discussion

The Oversight Consumption Role identifies responsibility for receiving authorised FX information as an external oversight participant.

This role includes receiving an FX Release Package, accepting release obligations, preserving receipt context where applicable, and supporting oversight review without gaining access to internal FX [Data Plane](#) information beyond the authorised release.

The Oversight Consumption Role participates primarily in the FX Logical [Policy and Release Plane](#). It also relates to the FX Logical [Audit and Provenance Plane](#) because release decisions, release packages, delivery context, and obligations require [traceability](#) and review.
