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Statement

Evidence SHALL identify recorded information supporting a claim.

Source

Part 1, Section 13.4: Core Conceptual Element Requirements.

Rationale

Evidence provides recorded information that supports a claim made by the architecture, an implementation profile, a deployment profile, a test activity, or an operational observation. Defining Evidence as a conceptual element makes verification and audit support explicit.

This requirement preserves the role of Evidence as support for claims rather than as a substitute for the claims themselves.

Applies To

This requirement applies to Evidence references within the Conceptual Architecture.

It applies specifically to:

- Recorded information
- Architectural claims
- Verification claims
- Audit support
- Evidence traceability

Verification

Verification SHALL confirm that Evidence identifies recorded information supporting a claim.

Verification activities include review checks confirming that:

- Evidence references identify recorded information
- Evidence references identify the supported claim

- Evidence does not replace the architectural claim
- Evidence links support traceability from claim to recorded support
