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Statement

Each Logical Interaction Pattern SHALL identify [Evidence](#) expectations for later deployment, testability, and [Evidence](#) planning.

Source

Part 2, Section 16.7: Logical Interaction Requirements.

Rationale

Logical Interaction Patterns establish expectations that later Deployment, Testability, and Evidence Plans realise. Identifying Evidence expectations at the logical level preserves traceability and supports verification without introducing implementation-specific verification procedures into the Logical Architecture.

Applies To

This requirement applies to all Logical Interaction Patterns.

It applies specifically to:

- Logical Interaction Patterns;
- Evidence expectations;
- Deployment Profiles;
- Testability Plans; and
- Evidence Plans.

Verification

Verification SHALL confirm that each Logical Interaction Pattern identifies Evidence expectations for later realisation.

Verification activities should include review checks confirming that:

- Evidence expectations are explicitly identified;
- expectations support deployment and testing activities;

- Evidence expectations remain platform independent; and
- later plans preserve the identified expectations.

Traceability

This requirement supports traceability between Logical Interaction Patterns and later deployment, testability, and evidence artefacts.
