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Statement

The Developer Handbook SHALL define coding style requirements.

Source

Part 4, Section 21.11: Developer Handbook Requirements.

Rationale

Coding style requirements establish consistent practices for hand-authored Phase 0 implementation code.

Defined style supports readability, maintainability, reviewability, dependency discipline, generated-type usage, and consistent distinction between hand-authored logic and generated code.

Applies To

This requirement applies to:

- hand-authored Phase 0 source code;
- implementation modules;
- supporting modules;
- wrappers and adapters; and
- applicable code-review activities.

Verification

Verification SHALL confirm that the Developer Handbook defines coding style requirements.

Verification activities should include review checks confirming that:

- source and module organization is addressed;
- naming of functions, methods, classes, and constants is addressed;
- imports and dependencies are addressed;
- configuration and generated-type usage are addressed; and
- review expectations are addressed.

Traceability

This requirement establishes the coding discipline applied to Phase 0 hand-authored implementation artifacts.
