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Statement

The Developer Handbook SHALL define review checklist requirements.

Source

Part 4, Section 21.11: Developer Handbook Requirements.

Rationale

Review checklists provide a repeatable acceptance mechanism for determining whether implementation artifacts conform to the Phase 0 development baseline.

Defined checklist requirements allow reviewers to consistently assess headers, naming, coding style, logging, exception handling, traceability, repository placement, generation status, and other applicable concerns.

Applies To

This requirement applies to:

- implementation artifact review;
- source-file review;
- generated-file review;
- repository review; and
- acceptance into the Phase 0 implementation baseline.

Verification

Verification SHALL confirm that the Developer Handbook defines review checklist requirements.

Verification activities should include review checks confirming that:

- file-header checks are addressed;
- generated-file checks are addressed;
- naming and coding-style checks are addressed;
- logging, exception-handling, and traceability checks are addressed; and

- baseline-status and repository-location checks are addressed.

Traceability

This requirement establishes the review mechanism used before Phase 0 implementation artifacts enter the approved baseline.
