

P4-REQ-21-8-003

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Statement

Each interaction realization SHALL identify the implementation participants involved.

Source

Part 4, Section 21.8: Interaction Pattern Realization Requirements.

Rationale

Identifying participating implementation artifacts makes the allocation of responsibilities within each realized interaction explicit.

This allows reviewers to determine which Phase 0 participants perform the producing, consuming, processing, control, observation, or supporting responsibilities required by the interaction.

Applies To

This requirement applies to:

- implementation participants;
- runtime participants;
- implementation node modules; and
- interaction mapping records.

Verification

Verification SHALL confirm that each interaction realization identifies all implementation participants involved.

Verification activities should include review checks confirming that:

- producing participants are identified;
- consuming participants are identified;
- intermediate or supporting participants are identified where applicable; and
- each participant maps to an applicable logical responsibility.

Traceability

This requirement connects Phase 0 interaction realizations to the implementation participants that perform the applicable logical responsibilities.
