

# 7.6 Runtime Identifiers Do Not Replace Architectural Concepts

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Runtime identifiers must not replace architectural concepts.

Table 7.6-1: Examples of runtime identifiers that must not replace architectural concepts

| Do not treat this    | As this                                                   |
|----------------------|-----------------------------------------------------------|
| DDS Domain ID        | Runtime Plane                                             |
| DDS partition        | Runtime Plane                                             |
| Kubernetes namespace | Ecosystem or Domain                                       |
| Container name       | Node Identity                                             |
| Pod name             | Node Identity                                             |
| DDS Topic            | Communication Endpoint in all possible implementations    |
| IDL structure        | Data Structure Definition in all possible implementations |

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
