

5.1 Overview

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The [Archetype](#) Classification Model identifies the governed business, semantic, and institutional scope of an [Archetype](#).

The model gives each [Archetype](#) a stable [Classification Path](#) before later documents define logical models, implementation mappings, deployment profiles, or [Evidence](#) plans. This [Classification Path](#) helps authors and reviewers understand where an [Archetype](#) belongs and which financial [Domain](#) it addresses.

The classification model uses three primary levels:

├─ Ecosystem
│   └─ Domain
```

The classification hierarchy moves from broad to specific. An [Ecosphere](#) identifies a broad area under governance. An [Ecosystem](#) identifies a major functional area within an [Ecosphere](#). A [Domain](#) identifies a specific business or semantic area within an [Ecosystem](#).

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
