

5.7 Classification and Governance

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The classification model supports [Governance and Authority](#) by identifying the business and [Semantic](#) scope to which architectural decisions apply.

A requirement, [Logical Model \(LM\)](#), implementation profile, deployment profile, or [Evidence](#) claim can identify the [Classification Path](#) it addresses when scope matters. Identifying the applicable [Classification Path](#) helps reviewers distinguish between:

- A general [Financial System](#) rule
- A rule that applies to one [Ecosystem](#)
- A rule that applies to one [Domain](#)
- A rule that applies only to one implementation profile
- A rule that applies only to one deployment or [Evidence](#) package

The classification model, therefore, helps prevent local implementation decisions from appearing broader than they are.

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
