

6.2 Finance Ecosphere

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Discussion:

The [Finance Ecosphere](#) identifies the broad, governed area of financial activity that the Financial Systems Archetype addresses. It provides the highest-level classification for [Financial Systems](#) within this document set.

The [Finance Ecosphere](#) includes financial institutions, markets, instruments, transactions, obligations, reporting, oversight, supervision, risk analysis, settlement, and related structured-information processing activities.

Later [Ecosystems](#), [Domains](#), logical profiles, implementation profiles, deployment profiles, and [Evidence](#) plans inherit the [Finance Ecosphere](#) when they operate within the financial scope defined by this part.

Definition:

[Ecosphere](#) covering financial activity and financial structured information processing
