

13.2 Conceptual Separation Requirements

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This section identifies the normative requirements for conceptual separation established by Part 1. The canonical requirement statements are maintained in [Annex C: Requirements, Part 1](#).

Table 13.2-1: Part 1 conceptual separation requirements.

Requirement ID	Statement
P1-REQ-13-2-001	The Conceptual Architecture SHALL preserve separation between conceptual meaning, logical Structure , implementation mapping, deployment mechanics, testability, and Evidence .
P1-REQ-13-2-002	The Conceptual Architecture SHALL distinguish conceptual elements from logical elements, implementation artifacts, deployment artifacts, and Evidence .
P1-REQ-13-2-003	The Conceptual Architecture SHALL NOT allow implementation technologies to redefine conceptual elements.
P1-REQ-13-2-004	The Conceptual Architecture SHALL NOT allow deployment artifacts to redefine conceptual elements.
P1-REQ-13-2-005	The Conceptual Architecture SHALL NOT treat runtime identifiers as substitutes for conceptual elements.

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
