

4.6 Traceability from Concept to Logical Model

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The Logical Architecture preserves [Traceability](#) to the Part 1 conceptual foundation.

Each major logical element traces back to the conceptual element it specialises, refines, constrains, or relates to. Logical Nodes trace to [Node](#). [Logical Communication Endpoints](#) trace to [Communication Endpoint](#). [Logical information structures](#) trace to the [Data Structure Definition](#). Logical Runtime Planes trace to the [Runtime Plane](#).

This [Traceability](#) allows reviewers to confirm that Part 2 builds outward from Part 1 rather than replacing or redefining it.

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
