

11.1 Overview

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The Logical Governance Model defines the platform-independent governance relationships that govern definitions, versions, compatibility, admission, [policy constraints](#), change, and review within the distributed, node-based Logical Architecture / PIM.

Logical governance ensures that [Logical Nodes](#), [Logical Communication Endpoints](#), [Logical Data Structure Definitions](#), Logical Runtime Planes, Logical Interaction Patterns, and logical traceability relationships evolve in a controlled and reviewable way.

The Logical Governance Model does not prescribe a repository, workflow tool, policy engine, approval system, access-control product, configuration system, or runtime governance service. Implementation and deployment profiles select mechanisms that realise logical governance for a specific implementation context.

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
