

14.8 Boundary Between Part 2 and Implementation Profiles

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Part 2 defines the platform-independent logical architecture. Implementation profiles define technology-specific realisations.

Part 2 identifies logical [Nodes](#), [Communication Endpoints](#), [information structures](#), Runtime Planes, interaction patterns, governance relationships, and [Traceability](#) relationships. It does not bind those logical elements to implementation technologies or deployment mechanisms.

An Implementation Profile / PSM provides the technology-specific mapping while preserving logical meaning and [Traceability](#). This boundary allows different implementation profiles to realise the same Logical Architecture / PIM using different technologies while preserving the same logical relationships.

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
