

15.3 Logical Endpoints Remain Distinct from Communication Technologies

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A [Logical Communication Endpoint](#) represents a platform-independent point of information exchange among [Logical Nodes](#). It does not represent a DDS Topic, REST resource, RPC method, Protocol Buffers service, message queue, event stream, file, database handoff, shared memory location, or network route.

Implementation profiles select communication mechanisms that realize [Logical Communication Endpoints](#). The selected mechanism supports logical exchange but does not redefine the endpoint's logical purpose, participating [Nodes](#), [Communication Roles](#), information structures, Runtime Plane classification, governance constraints, or [Evidence](#) expectations.

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
