Logical interaction [Traceability](#) supports review, impact analysis, compatibility assessment, auditability, replay, reconstruction, and [Evidence](#) planning.

Implementation and deployment profiles preserve this [Traceability](#) by mapping logical interactions to selected communication mechanisms, runtime artefacts, deployment artefacts, test scenarios, and [Evidence](#) records.

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
