

15.7 Logical Architecture Does Not Prescribe Deployment Topology

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The Logical Architecture / PIM defines logical structure, not deployment topology.

It does not prescribe centralised deployment, federated deployment, colocated execution, distributed execution, cloud deployment, on-premises deployment, hybrid deployment, multi-jurisdiction deployment, Kubernetes deployment, container deployment, or single-machine execution.

Deployment profiles define topology for a specific environment. Those deployment choices realise the Logical Architecture under selected operational constraints. They do not redefine [Logical Nodes](#), [Logical Communication Endpoints](#), Logical Runtime Planes, or [Logical Data Structure Definitions](#).

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
