The FX Demo Logical Profile preserves [Runtime Plane](#) separation within the [Foreign Exchange Domain](#).

FX [Logical Control Plane](#) interactions coordinate operational behaviour. FX [Logical Data Plane](#) interactions carry FX domain and analytical information. FX [Logical Health and Observability Plane](#) interactions report the FX logical [Node](#) condition. FX [Logical Policy and Release Plane](#) interactions govern access, disclosure, safeguarding, and release. FX [Logical Audit and Provenance Plane](#) interactions preserve reconstruction, lineage, accountability, and defensibility.

Cross-plane relationships connect these concerns without collapsing them. A health observation triggers control action. An [FX Validation Result](#) requires release evaluation before external disclosure. A release decision creates [FX Audit Record](#) and [FX Provenance Record](#). An [FX Replay Request](#) connects control, data, audit, and provenance concerns.
