The FX Demo Runtime Plane Model specializes the Part 2 Logical Runtime Plane Model for the [Foreign Exchange Domain](#).

FX [Runtime Planes](#) classify FX logical interactions by architectural purpose. They distinguish operational coordination, FX domain information exchange, health reporting, governed release, audit, provenance, replay, reconstruction, and [Evidence](#) expectations.

The FX Demo Runtime Plane Model does not prescribe [DDS](#) domains, [DDS](#) topics, [DDS](#) partitions, [REST](#) resource groups, [RPC](#) services, message queues, event streams, Kubernetes namespaces, network segments, security zones, deployment environments, or runtime configuration groupings. Implementation and deployment profiles select mechanisms that realize FX [Runtime Plane](#) separation.
