FX Demo Logical Interaction Patterns specialise the Part 2 Logical Interaction Patterns for the [Foreign Exchange Domain](#).

Each pattern identifies the participating FX logical [Nodes](#) or [Node Roles](#), FX logical [Communication Endpoints](#), FX logical information structures, FX [Runtime Planes](#), governance constraints, [Traceability](#) relationships, and [Evidence](#) expectations involved in the interaction.

The FX Demo Logical Interaction Patterns remain platform-independent. They do not prescribe [DDS](#), [REST](#), [RPC](#), [Protocol Buffers](#), message queues, event streams, file exchange, shared services, databases, logs, deployment mechanisms, runtime scripts, or evidence-capture tools. Implementation and deployment profiles select the mechanisms that realise these patterns.

The patterns in this section provide the reusable FX logical behaviour that Part 4 maps to implementation artefacts and Part 5 deploys, tests, observes, and provides [Evidence](#) for.

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
