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The FX Demo Logical Profile applies the following constraints:

- FX logical [Nodes](#) remain distinct from runtime deployments.
- FX logical [Communication Endpoints](#) remain distinct from communication technologies.
- FX logical information structures remain distinct from serialisation formats and implementation schemas.
- FX [Runtime Planes](#) remain distinct from implementation groupings.
- FX logical interactions remain [Traceable](#).
- The FX Demo Logical Profile does not prescribe deployment topology.
- The FX Demo Logical Profile does not prescribe the implementation of communication patterns.
- The FX Demo Logical Profile does not prescribe governance tooling.
- Implementation Profiles / [PSMs](#) preserve the FX Demo Logical Profile while mapping FX logical elements to selected technologies.
- Deployment, Testability, and [Evidence](#) Plans preserve the FX Demo Logical Profile while deploying, testing, observing, and evidencing selected implementation artefacts.

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
