

5.7 Runtime Plane Discipline in Implementation

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Phase 0 implementation work must preserve [Runtime Plane](#) discipline.

Implementation artifacts must distinguish Control Plane, Data Plane, Health and Observability Plane, Policy and Release Plane, and Audit and Provenance Plane concerns. A single implementation mechanism may address concerns from more than one plane, but it must still preserve the purpose, [traceability](#), and review expectations associated with each plane.

This principle prevents implementation convenience from collapsing architectural concerns. A status report, control command, transaction record, policy decision, audit record, and provenance record may all move through implementation mechanisms, but each retains its Runtime Plane meaning.

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
