

15.2 Purpose of the Developer Handbook

The Phase 0 Developer Handbook provides the required development conventions for producing Phase 0 implementation artifacts.

The handbook must help contributors:

- Create files with consistent headers and [Traceability](#) metadata
- Distinguish generated artifacts from hand-authored artifacts
- Follow approved naming conventions
- Follow approved coding style
- Use logging consistently
- Handle exceptions consistently
- Preserve [Runtime Plane](#) distinctions in implementation behavior
- Follow repository workflow
- Run approved scripts correctly
- Avoid uncontrolled prototype code
- Prepare artifacts for later deployment, testability, observation, and [Evidence](#) planning

The handbook turns implementation discipline into repeatable developer practice.

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
