

15.3 Handbook Approval before Coding

Go To Phase 0 Developer Handbook Requirements

The Phase 0 Developer Handbook must exist and receive approval before Phase 0 coding begins.

This requirement applies to hand-authored source code, generated code, scripts, configuration artifacts, repository contributions, and implementation documentation that become part of the Phase 0 implementation baseline.

Planning notes, experiments, or exploratory material may exist outside the implementation baseline only when the repository workflow clearly marks them as non-baseline material. Non-baseline material must not be confused with approved Phase 0 implementation artifacts.

No Phase 0 implementation artifact should enter the implementation baseline unless the applicable handbook rules exist and reviewers can apply them.

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
