

20.1 Overview

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The Phase 0 Implementation Rules and Constraints define the boundaries that preserve the relationship between the FX Demo Logical Profile and the Phase 0 Implementation Profile / PSM.

These rules prevent implementation artefacts, technologies, generated artefacts, [Repository](#) structures, scripts, Developer Handbook rules, [Deployment](#) concerns, or [Evidence](#) concerns from redefining the conceptual, logical, or FX logical profile layers.

Section 21 expresses the formal Phase 0 implementation [Requirements](#). This section explains the implementation rules and constraints that motivate those Requirements.

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
