

20.3 DDS Topics Do Not Redefine Logical Communication Endpoints

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A [DDS](#) Topic realises an FX logical [Communication Endpoint](#) for the selected Phase 0 implementation context.

The DDS Topic name, [Data Type](#), [QoS](#) profile, publisher, subscriber, and [Configuration](#) provide the implementation mechanism for exchange. They do not redefine the logical Endpoint, its purpose, participating FX logical [Nodes](#), [Communication Roles](#), carried information structure, [Runtime Plane](#) classification, governance constraints, or [Traceability](#) relationships.

Later phases may extend, refine, supersede, or replace the DDS Topic mapping while preserving Traceability to the FX logical Communication Endpoint.

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
