

20.7 Repository Layout Does Not Redefine Architecture

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[Repository](#) structure organises implementation artefacts. It does not define the architecture.

Directories, file locations, generated-code locations, [Configuration](#) locations, script locations, documentation locations, and build-output locations support implementation discipline and review. They do not redefine FX logical [Nodes](#), [Communication Endpoints](#), information structures, [Runtime Planes](#), interaction patterns, governance relationships, or [Traceability](#) relationships.

Repository organisation must support Traceability, generation discipline, review, and later Part 5 [Deployment](#) and [Evidence](#) planning.

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
