P4-REQ-21-11-003	The Developer Handbook SHALL define generated-file header conventions.
P4-REQ-21-11-004	The Developer Handbook SHALL define naming conventions.
P4-REQ-21-11-005	The Developer Handbook SHALL define coding style requirements.
