

2.3 Relationship to FDIS-RA

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FDIS-RA gives the project its financial-domain interpretation alignment. It helps the team distinguish **Data**, metadata, attributes, parameters, **Lifecycle** behaviour, monitoring, signals, indicators, and oversight.

This handbook does not implement the full FDIS-RA. Instead, it prepares the Phase 0 **Baseline** so that later phases can add financial-domain **Interpretation** without turning the system into ad hoc code. Phase 0 establishes the **Repository** structure, **Node** pattern, generated **Artifact** discipline, **DDS** topic conventions, logging expectations, and **Control Plane** behaviour that later FDIS-aligned work will need.

The team should use FDIS-RA as the source of financial-domain Interpretation meaning. The team should use this handbook to carry that meaning into executable Artifacts in a disciplined and repeatable way.

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
