

4.5 Configuration Directories

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The `config/` directory should contain [Configuration](#) files that developers and runtime scripts use to build, run, observe, and validate the Phase 0 [Baseline](#). These may include [Node](#) Configuration files, [DDS](#) Configuration files, [QoS](#) profile files, container Configuration files, logging Configuration files, and demonstration Configuration files.

A representative structure is:

```
config/  
  nodes/  
  dds/  
  qos/  
  logging/  
  demo/
```

Configuration files should use predictable names and should avoid machine-specific assumptions. They should not depend on absolute local paths, developer-specific usernames, personal directories, or unrecorded environment variables.

Where Configuration values differ across environments, the team should use templates, sample files, or documented environment variables. The [Repository](#) should distinguish shared Baseline Configuration from local developer overrides.

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
