

19.9 Full Multi-Vendor Interoperability

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Phase 0 does not require full multi-vendor interoperability unless the applicable checklist instance and acceptance criteria explicitly include it. The architecture may anticipate DDS interoperability across conforming implementations, but Phase 0 may use a single primary DDS product to establish the initial baseline.

If Phase 0 includes more than one DDS product, the team should identify which products it tested, which version ranges it used, which generated [Artifacts](#) it produced, which runtime combinations it validated, and which interoperability claims the [Evidence](#) supports.

Later phases may expand interoperability testing across DDS vendors, operating systems, container runtimes, generated bindings, QoS profiles, and deployment environments.

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
