

9.1 Core Concepts

The Cost Recovery, Compensation, and Settlement Plane uses a small set of core concepts to support economic accountability.

- A Chargeable Work Unit identifies a measurable unit of governed work for cost attribution.
- A Work Performed Event identifies completed governed work.
- A Qualified Node identifies a Node recognised as eligible to perform a defined governed function.
- A Qualified Service Provider identifies an accountable participant recognised as eligible to provide one or more governed functions.
- An Evidence Reference links a record to supporting evidence without exposing the full evidence payload.
- A Compensation Claim records a request for economic recognition for governed work.
- A Cost Rule determines economic treatment for governed work.
- A Settlement Instruction identifies settlement treatment for governed work.
- A Non-Performance Indicator identifies a lack of evidence for required governed work.
- Competitive Substitution supports the replacement of one qualified implementation by another qualified implementation for the same governed function.
- Content Minimisation limits exposed information to the information needed for an assigned purpose.
- Under-Compliance identifies failure to satisfy an applicable obligation for governed work.

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
