

11. Market Integrity Controls

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Market Integrity Controls protect the Governed Node Service Market from misuse, under-compliance, improper substitution, excessive disclosure, domination, arbitrary exclusion, and unreviewable governance action.

The market depends on trust. [Buyers](#), [Integrators](#), [Regulators](#), [Auditors](#), [Governance Bodies](#), [Qualified Service Providers](#), and [Qualified Nodes](#) need confidence that governed work is assigned only to eligible participants, that compensation depends on evidenced performance, that substitution does not bypass obligations, and that governance actions follow reviewable rules.

Market Integrity Controls preserve that trust by defining how the market limits information exposure, applies governance rules, suspends or removes participants, and supports appeals and reviews.

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
